### Notice of Public Hearing Town of North Collins

The Town of North Collins will conduct a public hearing on March 11, 2024, at Town Hall, 10569 Main Street, North Collins, NY, 14111. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comments on the completion of the Senior Center Improvement Project through Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project #2632CVPF40-22. The CDBG program, administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), allocates resources to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, primarily benefiting low/moderate-income individuals.

The hearing will provide information on the recent completion of the CDBG project, which involved the construction of the Senior Life Trail with associated stations, furnishing the Senior Computer Lab, and installing specific amenities like basketball backboards, picnic tables, garbage receptacles, and pet waste stations around the trail. These initiatives collectively enhance the Senior Center's offerings to the community, supported by funding from New York State Homes & Community Renewal.

Comments regarding the administration's effectiveness of the CDBG project will be accepted during this hearing. The event is conducted in accordance with Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR, and complies with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
