WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire has heretofore adopted a Traffic Ordinance commonly known and designated as the Traffic Ordinance of the Town of Yorkshire; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has heretofore adopted Local Law No. 1 - 1979 to provided for parking regulations by adding Article IV-A to the Traffic Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to amend the Traffic Ordinance and Local Law No. 1 - 1979 to provide for additional parking regulations at the Town Hall;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by § 1660 (d) of the Vehicle & Traffic Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire does hereby enact the following Local Law amending the Traffic Ordinance of the Town of Yorkshire and Local Law No. 1 - 1979 to establish additional parking regulations and enforcement, as follows:

SECTION 1.

ARTICLE IV -A

PARKING REGULATIONS

Section 1. Parking Prohibited in Designated Locations.

B. The overnight parking of vehicles at the Town Hall located at 82 Main Street in the Village of Delevan, County of Cattaraugus and State of New York between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M., is hereby prohibited.

The Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to erect appropriate signs for the enforcement of this provision.

SECTION 2.

ARTICLE VI

REMOVAL AND STORAGE OF VEHICLES

Section 7. Authority to Impound Vehicles.

(c) When any vehicle is parked or abandoned on any highway or parking area where stopping, standing or parking is prohibited, said vehicle may be removed by the Superintendent of Highways.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the filing thereof with the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.



THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR THE TOWN OF YORKSHIRE

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire as follows:

SECTION 1:

The tax levy limit for the Town of Yorkshire shall be Thirty Five Thousand One Hundred Five (\$35,105.00) Dollars for the year 2014.

SECTION 2:

This Local Law shall be submitted for approval to the Yorkshire Town Board at the next general Town Board Meeting and Public Hearing on October 21, 2013.

SECTION 3:

Any other Local Law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State after approval by 60% percent of the members of the Yorkshire Town Board in accordance with the requirements of Section 3-C of Subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law.

AMENDMENT TO LOCAL LAW 1-1975

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION LAW

Pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 578 of the Laws of 1974, the Town of Yorkshire in the County of Cattaraugus and State of New York does hereby make, publish and declare the following rules and regulations concerning Freedom of Information:

SECTION 1: The Town Clerk is hereby designated the Records Access Officer of the Town of Yorkshire. The records of the Town of Yorkshire shall be available for public inspection at the Town Hall, 82 South Main Street, Delevan, New York 14042, telephone: 716-492-1640; during regular business hours as is currently in place by the Town Clerk.

SECTION 2: The Records Access Officer shall upon request make a copy or copies of any records subject to such inspection upon payment of a fee of \$.25 per page or as is currently set by the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire.

If a copy or copies are desired by the requestor, the records Access Officer shall make the same and mail or notify the requestor within one week of their availability for pick up, depending upon the volume of copies requested.

SECTION 3: The Records Access Officer shall upon request, certify a copy of a document or record prepared pursuant to the provisions above upon payment of a fee of \$1.00 or in an amount as currently set by the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire.

SECTION 4: The Records Access Officer is hereby authorized to delete certain identifying details from public records in order to prevent unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Such unwarranted invasion of personal privacy includes, but shall not be limited to, the following:

- A. Disclosure of such personal matters as may have been reported in confidence to the Town Board of the Town of Yorkshire and which are not relevant or essential to the ordinary work of the Town of Yorkshire;
- B. Disclosure of employment, medical, credit history or personal references of applicants for employment; except such records as may be disclosed when the applicant has provided a written release permitting such disclosure;

- C. Disclosure of items involving the medical or personal records of a client or a patient in a hospital or medical facility;
- D. The sale or release of lists of names and addresses in the possession of the Town of Yorkshire if such lists are to be used for private, commercial or fund raising purposes;
- E. Disclosure of items of a personal nature when disclosure would result in economic or personal hardship to such party and said records are not relevant or essential to the ordinary work of the Town of Yorkshire; and
- F. Any additional limitations as are contained in Section 87 of the Public Offices Law of the State of New York.

PLEASE OBSERVE THESE RULES FOR FILING LOCAL LAWS WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE:

1. Each local law shall be filed with the Secretary of State within 20 days after its final adoption or approval as required by section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law. The cited statute provides that a local law shall not become effective before it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
2. Each local law to be filed with the Secretary of State shall be an original.
3. Each local law shall be filed on a form provided by the Department of State, as attached hereto. In case additional pages are required, they must be on the same letter size as the form provided. For convenience, printed, mimeographed or typewritten copies of the local law may be pasted on the form, but these must not be of a size larger than the form and printing must be on only one side of the sheet. Only true and legible copies will be accepted for filing.
4. **ONLY THE NUMBER, TITLE AND TEXT OF THE LOCAL LAW SHALL BE FILED.** In case of a local law amending a previously enacted local law or ordinance, the text must be that of the law as amended. Do not include in copy parts of old law to be omitted.
5. For the purpose of filing with the Secretary of State, number local laws consecutively, and start with the number one in each calendar year. It is suggested that introductory identifying numbers be used while a proposed local law is being considered.
6. Each copy of a local law filed with the Secretary of State shall have affixed to it a certification by the Clerk of the County legislative body or the City, Town or Village Clerk or other officer designated by the local legislative body. There shall also be attached or annexed thereto a certification executed by the County Attorney, Corporation Counsel, Town Attorney, Village Attorney or other authorized attorney that the local law contains the correct text and that all proper proceedings have been had or taken for its enactment. Certification forms are provided herewith.


