Local Law No. 6 of the year 2023

Village of Ellicottville, County of Cattaraugus, State of New York

A local law Imposing a 4 Month Moratorium on the Processing of any Applications for, Approvals, or Permits for the Siting of any Facilities for Use or Distribution of Cannabis.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Ellicottville, NY time to complete the adoption of zoning and land use regulations pertaining to the siting of cannabis use and sales facilities in order to prevent the siting of such operations fromimposing nuisance conditions on other Village activities.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to New York Village Law 7-700, 7-712, 7-718, and 7-725which expressly authorizes a New York State Village the power to regulate the use and locations of properties within the Village, and impose reasonable conditions on the same.

Section 3. Adoption of Moratorium on actions related to the siting of Cannabis Use or Distribution Facilities.

The Village hereby adopts Local Law # 6 of 2023 establishing a Temporary Moratorium of four months on the acceptance of permit applications, the processing of permit applications, the granting of variances, the granting of Special Use Permits, or the issuance of building Permits, for the establishment of facilities selling or allowing on site use of Cannabis, Marijuana, or Marihuana in order to allow the Village Board to consider and adopt as determined necessary recommendations of the Village Planner for the siting of facilities for the use and distribution of Cannabis.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON ACCEPTING, PROCESSING, AND ISSUING OF PERMITS FOR RETAIL SALE OF CANNABIS, MARIHUANA, OR MARIJUANA

WHEREAS, the Village of Ellicottville New York (The Village) exists as a community of approximately 400 full time residents, with a geographic area of approximately525 acres, that serves as a regional destination to visitors seeking to enjoy The Village's unique natural resources, and a walkable Village Character, with many of those visitors coming from the nearby States of Pennsylvania, and Ohio; and

WHEREAS, In March of 2021 the Governor of New York signed into law Marihuana Regulation & Taxation Act (MRTA) to decriminalize certain possessions and regulate sales of Cannabis (a/k/a Marijuana or Marijuana) as an adult activity; and

WHEREAS, has comprehensive zoning scheme that regulates commercial activity, in a manner which protects the residential fabric, and also attempts to prevent nuisance impacts of commercial activity from impacting the safe passage through the streets of Ellicottville, and otherwise interfaring with the enjoyment of the Village by residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS the proximate States of Ohio and Pennsylvani have b=not allowed for the sales and use of Marijauna; and

WHEREAS, the initial allowance for the regulation and use of Marijuana in Massachusetts demonstrated that Cannabis retail and use facilities can create heavy parking demands in communities likely to draw Cannabis consumers in from neighboring states; and

WHEREAS the Village of Ellicotville has had the Village Planner working with the Village Attorney, Village Board members, and community members to draft a comprehensive set of regulations that will allow for the siting of some cannabis use and distribution facilities in certain commercial and industrial zoned properties, subject to restrictions on density, parking, signage, and separation from residential fabric, and other site conditions of local import; and another construction and use of property for primary residential, which are designed to limit deleterious effects on neighboring properties; and

WHEREAS, The Village reasonably expects that within about four months it will be able to adopt local land use controls which will allow for the siting of some cannabis use and retail facilities in the Village; and it is now hereby

DETERMINED, Thatin order to protect the existent character of the Village, and prevent sales and use of cannabis from having a deleterious effect on the Village a Temporary Moratorium on the issuance of permits and/or approvals for the sale and use of Cannabis is necessary, and it is accordingly

RESOLVED that The Village hereby adopts Local Law # 6 of 2023establishing a Temporary Moratoriumof four months on the acceptance of permit applications, the processing of permit applications, the granting of variances, the granting of Special Use Permits, or the issuance of building Permits, for the establishment of facilities selling or allowing on site use of Cannabis, Marijuana, or Marihuana in order to allow the Village Board to consider and adopt as determined necessary recommendations of the Village Planner for the siting of facilities for the use and distribution of Cannabis.

EVGV Trail

Ms. O'Striker spoke on the CFA – Consolidated Funding Application for a reimbursable matching grant – 50/50 match. We can apply up to \$500,000. The project in the park is \$486,000 using asphalt (\$243,000 grant/\$243,000 match). She also stated that the EVGV Trail is intending on raising the match which can included: through our regular fundraising efforts, applying for other grants such as the Ralph Wilson Foundation and we can also use Professional Services, Supplies and Materials, Volunteer Labor – donated services from construction company, labor, equipment, etc.

Chuck Parenti - Short Term Rentals

I am a permanent resident located at 25 Parkside Drive. I would love to see the code changed not just high density but across the board for all short term rentals. Basically he would like to see full time residents and shouldn't have short term rentals on Fillmore Avenue. He understands long term rentals and would like to see us do away with all short term rentals in residential areas. Enforce and prosecution is the tough part stated Mayor Burrell

Kendra Pitillo – Revise Open Container Law

Ms. Pitillo spoke to the ability to have alcoholic beverages on the Street on occasion with doing all of the proper preparations. Mayor Burrell responded we have a permit in place. There was a time we the Village waived the open container law.

Local law needs to be rewritten. Will someone get this started stated Kendra? Should we discuss to bring this to a public hearing? After some discussion Ms. Pitillo will be on the committee, no one from the board volunteered to be on the committee.

41 Washington Street – They would like to push the building back and make the porch smaller. We need the owner to hold the village harmless and if New York State responds they have to act accordingly.

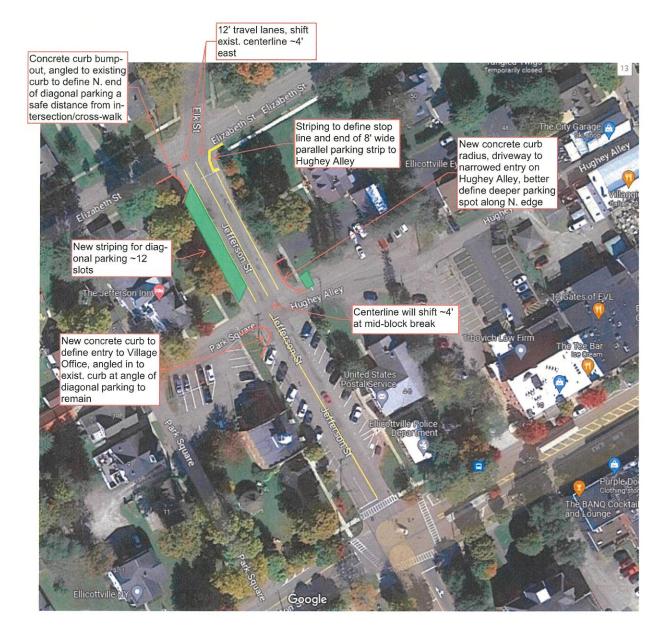
