SECTION 1. Local Law 1-1971 continuing the office of elected assessors is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Article 15-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, from and after the effective date of this law, there shall be but one assessor, to be appointed by the Town Board as provided in said Article.

SECTION 3. Upon the establishment of the office of appointed assessor by this law, the terms of office of all assessors then in office shall terminate.

SECTION 4. This local law shall be subject to a permissive referendum and shall not take effect until at least forty-five (45) days after its adoption or until it has been approved by affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Town voting on a proposition for its approval if within forty-five (45) days after its adoption there be filed with the Town Clerk a petition protesting against such local law pursuant to the provisions of Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that there has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Machias, Cattaraugus County, New York, Local Law No. 1 -2001 entitled "A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING THE OFFICES OF ELECTED ASSESSOR AND ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF A SINGLE APPOINTED ASSESSOR" and providing that Local Law No. 1-1971 continuing the office of elected assessors be repealed and after the effective date of this local law there shall be but one assessor to be appointed by the Town Board pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1522 of the Real Property Tax Law.
