Project Location Map

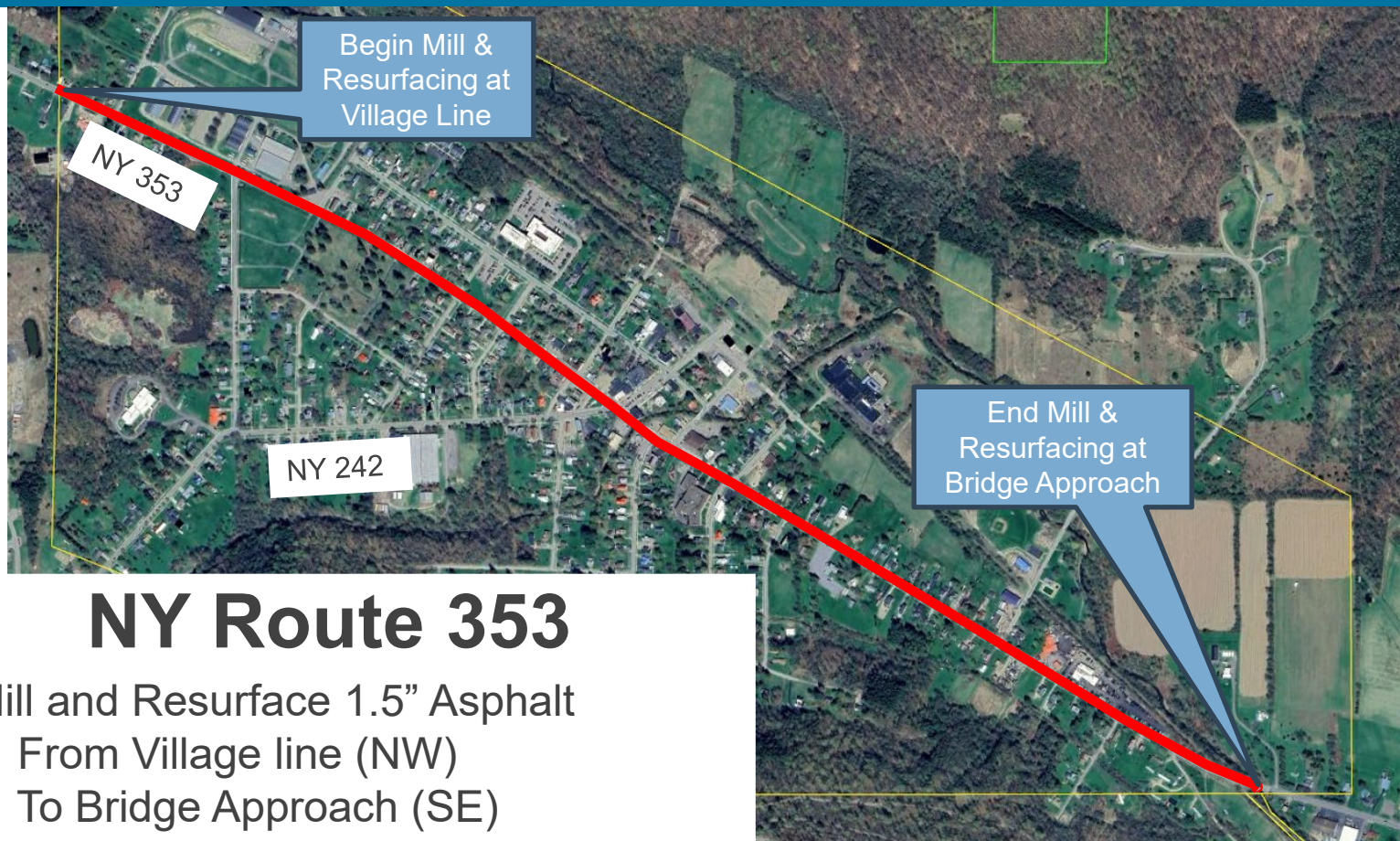


Purpose/Objective

- 1) Restore pavement to a good condition using cost effective treatments
- 2) Correct safety deficiencies using cost effective crash reduction methods
- 3) Repair/replace drainage structures and alleviate flooding issues on NY 242
- 4) Upgrade traffic signal and warning beacons to meet current standards
- 5) Increase pedestrian accessibility and safety by meeting current standards

Description of Proposed Work

- 1) NY 353 - Mill and overlay, NY 242 - Full depth reconstruction of the brick overlay section with minor change of geometry to meet current standards.
- 2) Realign the intersection of NY 353 at NY 242 outside the village limits to eliminate the skew.
- 3) Repair/replace drainage structures as necessary. Install new drainage structures and outlet on NY 242.
- 4) Upgrade traffic signal electronics and warning beacons to current standards.
- 5) Modified or replaced curb ramps as needed to bring them into compliance with ADAAG, PROWAG, and NYSDOT Standards.

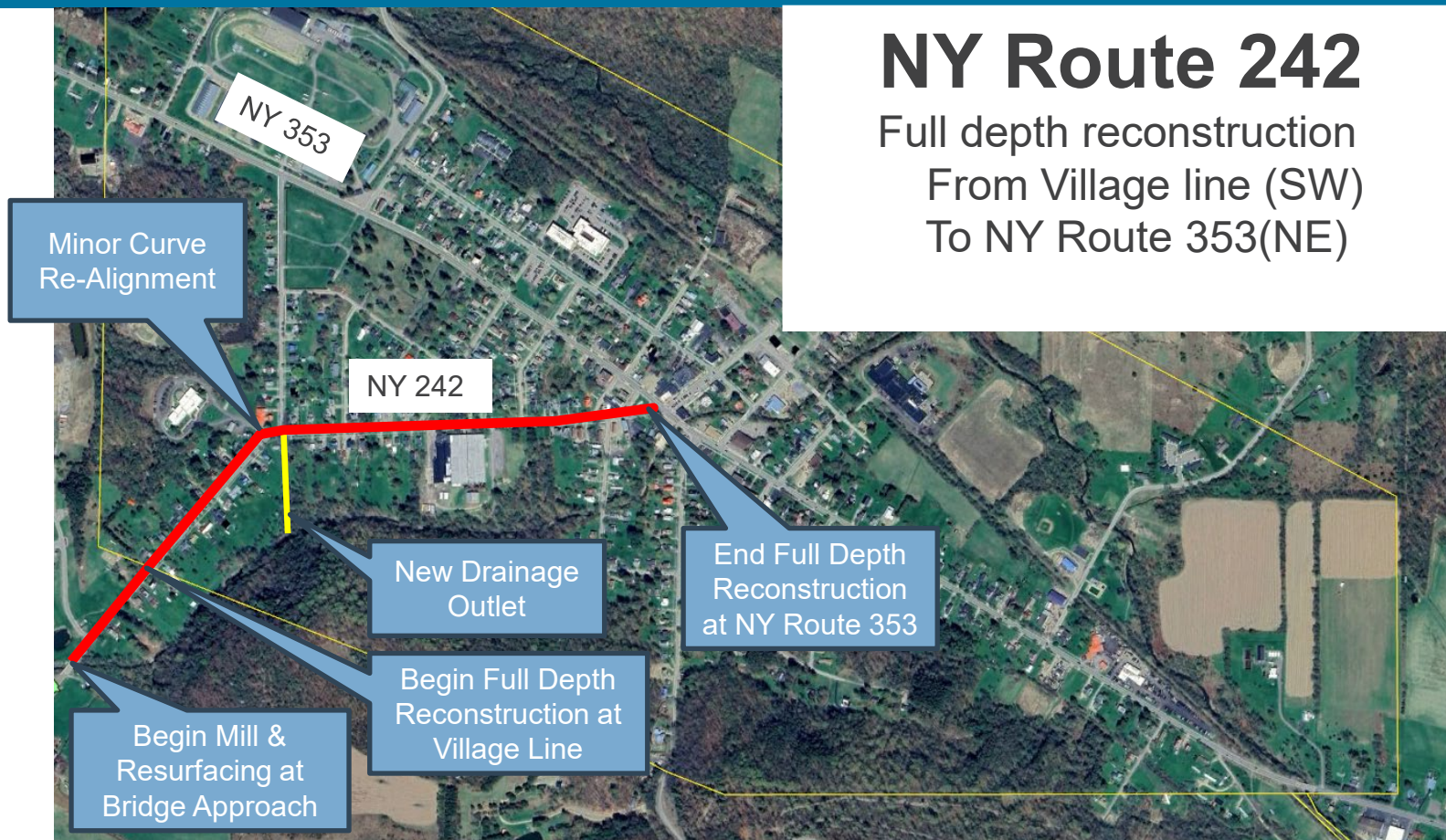


NY Route 353

To Bridge Approach (SE)

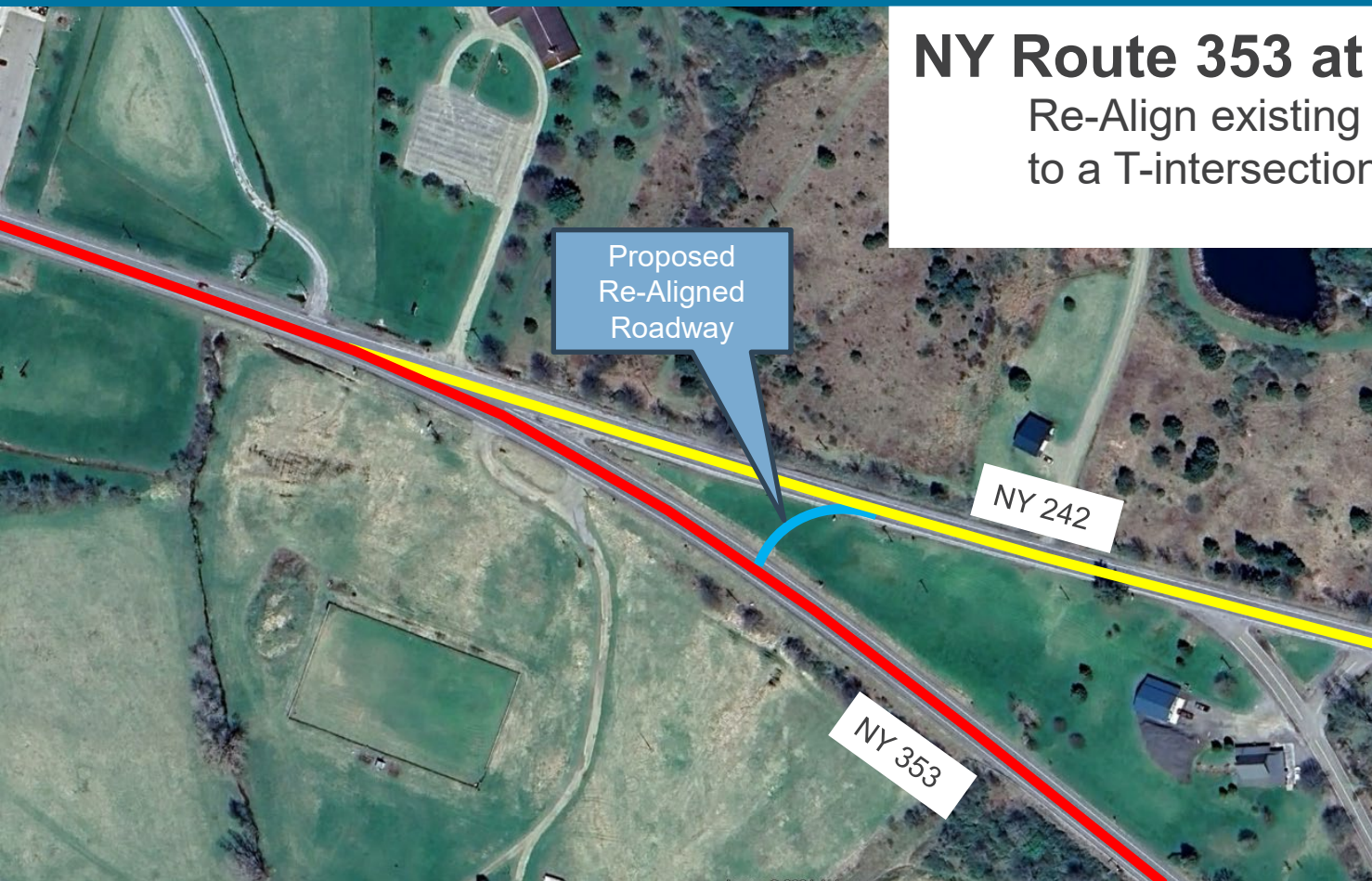
NY Route 242
