LOCAL LAW NUMBER 2 of 2018
Town of Carrollton

Pursuant to Section 458-B of the Real Property Tax Law and Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law

A LOCAL LAW GRANTING A PARTIAL REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR COLD WAR VETERANS

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Carrollton, in the County of Cattaraugus, as follows:

SECTION 1. It is the intent of this Local Law to grant a partial exemption of fifteen (15) percent of the assessed value of qualified residential real property, as defined in Real Property Tax Law Section 458-B(2)(a)(ii) to Cold War Veterans, as defined in Real Property Tax Law Section 458-B(1)(a).

SECTION 2. The Town of Carrollton hereby provides that qualifying residential real property will be exempt from Town real property taxation to the extent of fifteen (15) percent of the assessed value of such property; provided however, that such exemption will not exceed \$12,000 or the product of \$12,000 multiplied by the latest state equalization rate of the assessing unit, or in the case of a special assessing unit, the latest class ratio, whichever is less, for Cold War Veterans as described in New York State Real Property Tax Law Section 458-B.

SECTION 3. The Town of Carrollton hereby provides that the qualifying residential owners of qualifying real property will retain the exemption provided for in Section 2 of this local law for as long as they remain qualifying owners without regard to the ten year limitation on exemption as provided for in Real Property Tax Law Section 458-B(2)(c)(iii).

SECTION 4. If any provision of this Local law is adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then such adjudication will not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereon, but will be confined in its operation to the particular provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.
