

The New York State Department of Transportation would like to notify you of upcoming culvert and/or drainage structure improvements throughout various communities in Allegany County.

Throughout the construction season, improvements will be made on the following routes:

- State Route 305 - Cuba, Allegany County
 - Approximately 6 weeks
 - Work Zone – approximately 500' north of the Daggett Hollow Road and continue for 7.5 miles (house #2084 – house #4354)
 - 23 sites along route
- State Route 417 – Scio, Allegany County
 - Approximately 5 weeks
 - Work Zone – between W McKee Road and Knights Creek Road
 - 18 sites along route
- State Route 248 – Independence, Allegany County
 - Approximately 3 weeks
 - Work Zone – between Dutch Hill Road and continue to ½ mile past Beech Hill/ Grantier Road Intersection
 - 12 sites along route
- State Route 244 – Ward, Allegany County
 - Approximately 2 weeks
 - Work Zone – between Irish Settlement Road and Mulligan Road
 - 5 sites along route

Traffic will be maintained during the hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. using alternating single-lane closures and temporary traffic signals and/ or on-site flagging personnel. The temporary traffic signals will stay in one area for a maximum of three days and be continually moved along the route. Work at each site will vary between locations.

Work on Route 248 is scheduled to begin this week. As we have anticipated start dates for the remaining routes, I will update you.
