Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2021 Town of Independence, County of Allegany:

A local law adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131 opting out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town of Independence.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to opt the Town of Independence out of hosting retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to New York State Cannabis Law § 131, which expressly authorizes towns, cities and villages to opt-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments to locate and operate within their municipal boundaries.

Section 3. Local Cannabis Retail Dispensary and/or On-Site Consumption Opt-Out
The Town Board/Board of the Town of Independence, County of Allegany, hereby opts-out of
licensing and establishing cannabis retail dispensaries and/or cannabis on-site consumption
establishments within its boundaries and directs and requests the cannabis control board to
prohibit the establishment of such retail dispensary licenses and/or on-site consumption licenses
within the boundaries of the Town of Independence.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and thus may not be filed with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.
