Trustee Pockey moved, 2^{nd} by Trustee Hillman to accept the March 28, 2022, minutes as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Scheduled guests-

Trustee Pockey moved, 2nd by Trustee Hillman to enter public hearing to discuss amending zoning laws. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Sikora stated that the County Planning board reviewed the proposed changes and had no issues. No questions were submitted from the public.
