Legal proof of post and publishing was provided by Town Clerk, Rebecca Yacklon.

Supervisor Purol informed those present that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comment regarding the East Dunkirk Fire Protection Contract for 2023.

The requested amount was \$152,789 a 2 percent increase, generating a tax rate amount of \$2.02 per thousand of assessed value.

Chief Kyle Damon reviewed the proposed budget by line item to the Town Board. He stated due to inflation, fuel costs, and two new members they felt they were in need to ask for a two percent increase over last year. He had informed the board that last year they asked for the extra \$6,000, which was used to purchase an extractor.

Supervisor Purol thanked the Fire Company for their time and dedication and advised that the contract would be discussed and voted on at the November Town Board meeting.
