PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

Mr. Bono stated that Cooper Hill Road from Conlan Road to Button Road needs repair. He wanted to know what the plans are to fix the road. Highway Superintendent replied that the road would be repaired later in the summer. There are roads being tarred and chipped and once these are complete other roads will be repaired.

Assessor Bonnie Rae Strickland did not send a written report.

Terry Fuller, Code Enforcement Officer, presented a written report of permits issued and inspections done in June. The clerk received \$640.00 for fees collected. The CEO has been sending notices to property owners for violations on the Property Maintenance Law and for unlicensed campers.

There was no report from the Dog Control Officer.

Jason Pearl, Highway Superintendent, provided a written report. Millings have been hauled from the City of Olean and stored at the Town of Allegany for future use. Part of Conlan Road will have oil and stone applied once Verizon moves a phone lines that run through culverts that need to be replaced. They have also been helping the Town of Allegany pave roads.

Mary Weber reported \$155.00 in fees collected in June 2022, the Supervisor was presented a check for \$155.00. The Supervisor was also presented with a check from Tax Collection 2022 for interest and late fees totaling \$2226.77.

Carrie Childs, Supervisor, presented a written report for the month of June. A check for \$6,685.71 was received for county mortgage tax apportionment from 10/2021-3/2022. No update on the ongoing Bono lawsuit.

General Fund invoices #36-46 totaling \$3390.99 and prepaids for 446.99 and Highway invoices #91-100 totaling \$19,851.32 were circulated and signed.

David Moshier moved to pay the bills as presented, second by Scott Andrews, and the motion was carried by 4 votes in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 P.M. by a motion from Alicia Pearl, seconded by Carrie Childs and carried by 4 votes in favor.
