## Town of Freedom Special Meeting & Work Session Minutes March 28, 2022

Board Members Present: Josh Aarum, Geoff Milks, John Hill, R. Nick Morgan, & Supervisor Dustin Bliss

Other Officials Present: Highway Superintendent Jim Haggerty, Planning Board Member Lyle Morgan, Town Attorney Eric Firkel, & Article 7 Attorney Peter Sorgi

Meeting called to order at 6:03pm by Supervisor Dustin Bliss

I.PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: Led by Supervisor Dustin Bliss

- II. Opening of bids for the mower and tractor: Supervisor Dustin Bliss told the Board that only one bid had been received, and that the Town of Franklinville is interested and would like to put a bid in on the mower and tractor. The Highway Superintendent from Franklinville had to wait till their Town Board Meeting to ask the Board if he could bid on the mower and tractor. The Freedom Board agreed to wait till the April 18, Board Meeting to open the sealed bids.
- III. Discussion of Article 7 proceedings: Supervisor Dustin Bliss asked Sean Perry to discuss the handout that is attached. Shawn stated that this was a hand out they brought to the Board last winter when they discussed submitting the Article 7 application to the state. Now that the application has been deemed complete, that started the 12-month clock by which the process goes along. This is very similar to the Article 10 process. Marguerite Wells stated that the map that is in the board room is still the same as when they brought it in last year. Dustin stated the question he has is, at the County level there is politics being played as to whether or not they can wait it out and see what's going to happen. Dustin stated that its beneficial for the Town of Freedom if a PILOT is extended by the IDA, so the Town can utilize the terms in the Host Community Agreement to drive revenue from the project coming directly to this town. Dustin has talked to several people at the County and they are saying to him that Invenergy is not serious about this because they have not checked all the boxes on different studies that need to get done before the project can even go forward. Marguerite stated the only studies that need to get done are things that fall under the heading called compliance finals. That's the final site plans, it's basically a lot of what was in the Article 10 has to be updated in the final lay out. Dustin asked for more detail of what the compliance filings are. Marguerite said that it's a whole other Article 10 application put in piece by piece. They are basically final versions of everything that could be considered draft from the Article 10. She stated that if you look at the Article 10 certificate that was issues in May of 2020, it's a 150-page document and it's filled with conditions. So, there is a document to match every condition that is in there and that is what they need to file. Town Attorney Eric Firkel stated that he is not speaking for the County, but where they are coming from is that because none of the conditions have been meet yet, and in other projects when the certificate comes down the Article 10 whoever the developer is they start working on

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that immediately. Eric said that they are waiting for the project to move forward before they be willing to make a move. Marguerite said that's helpful. She also said that from their point of view it is moving forward and the Article 7 has been a key part of that, because until it was deemed complete, they could move forward with Article 7. She stated that in a year from when they were last here on the transmission line and now it took a lot longer to get the Article 7 complete then they had expected. The State Historical Preservation Office changed its rules in the middle of this process. All the studies they had done on SHIPO were on the old rules system and then they changed how they want studies done and how they want samples taken in the middle. She said that's why it took a year because they had to do a whole other year worth of studies. So now its deemed complete. Councilman John Hill asked if they can come up with a schedule of all the conditions of Article 7, so the Board knows exactly when they think they will have all the different completions for Article 10. Dustin stated it be more useful for the Town to be using the payments laid out in the HCA then though uniform assessment. There has to be a PILOT for that. Councilman Geoff Milks would like to see a comparison, being that the PILOT would be more lucrative to the Town then being assessed. He would like to see what the assessment data says. Marguerite explained that under the HCA the town gets a much bigger slice of the total dollar. Under the regular assessment method, no matter how many dollars in total the town would only get 12% of the total dollar.

Dustin asked Attorney Peter Sorgi where the Town stands with Article 7 proceedings. Peter said the first step is by Wednesday of this week to submit the form, application for intervenor funds. The funds are available to the Town of Freedom, Yorkshire and Cattaraugus County, also non-government groups as well. Then on April 12th, there will be a virtual meeting with the State to discuss the distribution of funds. There is \$100,000.00 available for studies, between all of the groups. \$50,000.00 goes to local governments to be divided up a certain way, and \$50,000.00 non-government stake holders. After April 12th, once they find out the amount the town is given for the studies, then Peter and the engineer will come back and sit down with the town. Then they would go through the whole submission and see what concerns there are and what needs to be addressed. Peter handed out some info to the Town Board please see attached. He explained what each page is talking about. The first 2 pages is the notice that the application is complete and that the intervenor funds are due by March 30th. He also said on the first page they must comply with 16 NYCRR §85-2.4 (d), which is the third page of NY code of rules and regulations. The remaining pages talk about all the documents that they have submitted this far, list all the party. The last two pages talks about the virtual conference on April 12, at 10 am. Peter said after April 12, they can sit down and go through the whole document.

Dustin asked if the Eric had any comments. Eric stated he would recommend that the Board reach out to the members of the County Legislator and just see where they are on things. Eric also said one thing that will be very helpful is the brake down numbers of PILOT vs NO PILOT.

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Peter asked Marguerite if this went to straight taxation who would get more? Marguerite said the County and the school district. She stated that under the PILOT plus HCA the town gets larger than 50% the total wattage. Scott Johnson stated that the pot is 5950 plus 5 so its 10950 is the pot, per megawatt rating.

Geoff asked what is the motivation for Invenergy or any big company to seek a PILOT, is it to get more money for the town or is it a benefit for the company as well. Marguerite stated no, it's more money with a PILOT plus an HCA. She stated because they are setting up long term residents with the town, with building stuff and employing local people, it serves them to be a good neighbor. She said that they actively work for a HCA. Geoff said he gets the HCA side, he just feels that the PILOT is because you are bringing in more employees, more money for the town, therefore you get a tax break. Marguerite said no, it more like the fixed dollar of a PILOT is helpful budget wise. The assessment method is a cheaper in the long run, but is a pain because you have to go through annual assessment, and it declines over time so it's less and less helpful to a town over time. She said they would rather stick a budget number in there and maintain the quality and its easier for the town to budget for as well. Peter asked are there any benefits to a PILOT, such as mortgage tax, and sales tax. Marguerite said that sales tax and mortgage recording tax are useful, lot of sales tax can still come from the state. She said the turbines are sales tax exempted anyways, because they are electrical generated equipment.

Additionally, paper copies can found at the Freedom and Yorkshire town halls, and the Arcade and Rushford public libraries.

The transmission line originates at a project substation to be built as part of the Wind Farm in the Town of Freedom, off of Osmun Rd. The transmission line will go west from there overhead on steel towers, into the town of Yorkshire, across State Route 16, to end at a new switchyard to be built adjacent to the existing 345 kV lines that are located in the Town of Yorkshire. The switchyard will not be visible from any public roads.

The Article VII application was filed on February 10, 2021, and contains project details and maps along with technical information on potential impacts of the project, such as visual, wetlands & waterway, wildlife, cultural resources, noise, and electromagnetic field studies. The evaluation and settlement process take 12-18 months.

NY - New York Codes, Rules and Regulations > TITLE 16. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE > CHAPTER I. RULES OF PROCEDURE > SUBCHAPTER G. CERTIFICATES OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED > PART 85. GENERAL PROCEDURES > SUBPART 85-2. PROCEDURES WITH RESPECT TO ALL ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES AND FUEL GAS TRANSMISSION LINES 10 OR MORE MILES LONG

### § 85-2.4 Fund for municipal and other parties

- (a) Each application that proposes an electric transmission facility of 125kV or more shall, at the time it is provided to the Secretary, be accompanied by a fee in the amount specified herein:
  - (1) if the proposed route for the facility is greater than 100.0 miles in length, \$ 450,000;
  - (2) if the proposed route for the facility is greater than 50.0 and up to 100.0 miles in length, \$ 350,000;
  - (3) if the proposed route for the facility would require a new right-of-way for 10.0% or more of its length and is from 10.0 to 50.0 miles long, \$ 100,000; and
  - (4) if the proposed route for the facility would use an existing right-of-way for more than 90.0% of its length and is from 10.0 to 50.0 miles long, \$ 50,000.
- (b) Any municipality or other party (except an applicant) may request funds to defray expenses for expert witness, consultant, administrative and legal fees (other than in connection with judicial review). Requests for funds shall be submitted to the presiding officer not later than 15 days after the issuance of a notice of the initial prehearing conference, unless otherwise specified by the presiding officer.
- (c) Subject to the availability of funds, the presiding officer may fix additional dates for submission of fund requests.
- (d) Each request for funds shall be submitted to the presiding officer, with copies to the other parties to the proceeding, and contain:
  - (1) a statement of the number of persons and the nature of the interests the requesting party represents;
  - (2) a statement of the availability of funds from the resources of the requesting party and from other sources and of the efforts that have been made to obtain such funds;

#### 16 NYCRR § 85-2.4

- (3) if the requesting party represents owners or occupants of real property, the location of such real property in relation to the route proposed for the facility and any alternative route specified as reasonable in the application;
- (4) the amount of funds being sought;
- (5) to the extent possible, the name and qualifications of each expert to be employed;
- (6) if known, the name of any other party who may, or is intending to, employ such expert;
- (7) a detailed statement of the services to be provided by expert witnesses, consultants or others (and the basis for the fees requested), specifying how such services will contribute to a complete record leading to an informed decision as to the appropriateness of the facility and route;
- (8) a statement as to the result of any effort made to encourage the applicant to perform any proposed studies or evaluations and the reason it is believed that an independent study is necessary; and
- (9) a copy of any contract or agreement or proposed contract or agreement with each expert witness, consultant or other person.
- (e) At any conference held to consider fund requests, the presiding officer shall discuss the award of funds and encourage the consolidation of requests.
- (f) Not later than 15 days after the close of the initial prehearing conference, the presiding officer shall make an initial award of funds, and from time to time thereafter may make additional awards of funds, in relation to the potential for such awards to make a contribution to a complete record leading to an informed decision as to the appropriateness of the facility and route.
- (g) If after its filing the application is amended in a manner that warrants substantial additional scrutiny, the Commission may require the applicant to pay an additional intervenor fee in an amount not to exceed \$ 125,000, and the presiding officer may make additional awards of funds, in relation to the potential for such awards to make a contribution to a complete record leading to an informed decision as to the appropriateness of the facility and route.
- (h) The presiding officer shall ultimately award, on an equitable basis, at least 50% of the funds to municipalities and up to 50% to other parties whose requests comply with the provisions of subdivisions (b) and (d) of this section, so long as the funds will contribute to a complete record leading to an informed decision as to the appropriateness of the transmission facility and route and facilitate broad public participation in the proceeding.
- (i) The fee submitted with each application, as well as any fee required to be submitted when an application is amended, shall be deposited in an intervenor account, established pursuant to <u>Section 97-tt</u> of the State Finance Law.
- (j) On a quarterly basis, unless otherwise required by the presiding officer, any municipality or other party receiving an award of funds shall:

#### 16 NYCRR § 85-2.4

- (1) provide an accounting of the monies that have been spent; and
- (2) submit a report to the presiding officer showing:
  - (i) the results of any studies conducted using such funds;
  - (ii) whether the purpose for which the funds were awarded has been achieved;
  - (iii) if the purpose for which the funds were awarded has not been achieved, whether reasonable progress toward the goal for which the funds were awarded is being achieved and why further expenditures are warranted.
- (k) Where it appears warranted, the presiding officer may incorporate the reports referred to in subdivision
- (j) of this section into the hearing record as public statements.
- (I) Disbursements from the intervenor account to municipal and other parties shall be made by the Department of Public Service upon audit and warrant of the Comptroller of the State on vouchers approved by the Chairman or a designee. Before any funds may be disbursed to a municipality or other party, such party must enter into a local assistance contract with the Department of Public Service. Vouchers prepared pursuant to such local assistance contract must be submitted for payment not later than six months after any withdrawal of an application or the Commission's final decision on an application (including a decision on rehearing, if applicable). Any funds that have not been disbursed shall be returned to the applicant after the Commission's final decision on an application (including any decision on rehearing or on remand following a court order, if applicable) has been made. If an application has been withdrawn, any funds remaining shall be returned within a reasonable time.
