SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

- Superintendent Zink updated the Board on the National Fuel Gas Line for Godfrey Hollow and the Highway Garage. Gas would be beneficial compared to oil or propane cost now. New appliances would be needed at the Town Garage such as replacing heaters. There is a possibility that the American Rescue Funding could be used for this. The Board agreed to commit to hooking up to the gas line. Superintendent Zink will keep the Board updated.
- There is a question about the water line on the city line to Steam Valley Road. It is unknown if the line is 4 inches or 12 inches. If it is 12 inches, fire hydrants could be installed. The city is looking into this information.
- Culverts have been changed from 12 inch pipes to 18 inch pipes in some areas.
- Potholes have been patched.
- Hydroseeding is being done on Steam Valley. This is covered by the grant under erosion control.
- Chip Sealing is complete on Happy Hollow Road, Park Avenue and parts of Goodrich Avenue.
 Seneca Avenue was crack sealed.
