**LOCAL LAW #1-2022**

**PARKING OR ABANDONMENT OF VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF MINA**

**A local law adopted pursuant to Section 10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law regulating parking on highways within the Town of Mina.**

**Section 1. Legislative Intent.**

It is the intent of this local law to regulate parking in the Town of Mina on highways, roads, streets and avenues within the Town of Mina boundaries during the months of November, December, January, February, and March to facilitate snow plowing and removal of snow.

**Section 2. Authority.**

This local law is adopted pursuant to Section 10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.

**Section 3. Regulation of Parking.**

The Town Board in and for the Town of Mina, County of Chautauqua, hereby prohibits the parking, whether the vehicle is attended or unattended, or the abandonment of vehicles on all highways, roads, streets, and avenues within the boundaries of the Town of Mina from 12:00 a.m. on November 1 of each year through and including March 31 at 11:59 p.m. of the succeeding year.

**Section 4. Violation of this Law.**

The owner of a vehicle in violation of this law shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one-hundred dollars (\$100.00). In addition, the Town, its employees, or agents, and the police are authorized to provide for the removal of such vehicle and storage thereof at the owner's expense, payable in full before the vehicle is released.

**Section 5. Supersession of Prior Law and/or Ordinance.**

It is the intent of the Town Board to supersede the provisions of Ordinance #1 of 1979, relating to the parking or abandonment of vehicles on highways in the Town of Mina.

**Section 6. Effective Date.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.
