- Nov 2023 Reviewing size and scope of project

#### Water Project

- o 1/3/2024 Formally accepted WIIA Grant
- o 12/12/23 Awarded up to \$5 Million NYS Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) Grant
- o 12/10/2023 Household Income Survey completed
  - 167/233 Surveys completed. 97 by mail and 70 in person
  - Median Household Income = \$50,000
  - 56.47% of households were below median county threshold of \$76,300
  - As a result, Clymer is in hardship status

# Comprehensive Plan

- o Recommended by County Planning Commission that we have one

#### IT Upgrades-

#### Sidewalks-

- Rebid in February for project to start after Tulip Festival (May 18<sup>th</sup>)
- ARPA Funds –we received \$169,230 in ARPA funding. Here is our draft list of priorities and uses:
  - Spent (\$75,912)
    - \$13,000 playground
    - o \$22,500 water engineering study process started with Barton and LoGuidice
    - o \$22,500 municipal building Study Christopher Cooke
    - \$1,000- Municipal Building Lot Survey Matt White
    - \$4,687 Surveillance Installation Town Park
    - \$11,225 park / pavilion improvements Spring- 2023
    - o \$1,000 board room office renovation
  - Allocated (\$93,318)
    - o \$90,000 Sidewalks
    - o \$3,318- Unassigned

ARPA funds must be fully allocated by December 2024, and spent by December 2026.
